The Purpose of this Student Handbook

The purpose of this Student Handbook is to ensure that students who have registered for Transformation Institute Course Offerings have clear understanding of what is required and expected from them as active participants in their training for reigning in the Kingdom of God.

This handbook has been prepared to provide important information related to student requirements, standards of conduct, and guidance to enable every Transformation Institute student to commit and successfully complete courses in the spirit of excellence while adhering to policies and procedures set forth by our Bishop and Co-Pastor.

Quarterly Course Offerings

Transformation Institute Quarterly Course Offerings are designed to elevate students into new levels of spiritual maturity, growth, and development.

These classes will challenge your present way of thinking and provoke you into higher dimensions of the Supernatural. The classes reflect the heart of our Bishop Daniel Robertson Jr. and Co-Pastor Elena Robertson who truly want to see us all be empowered and blessed so that we can empower and be a blessing to others. These classes have also been inspired by the Apostolic and Prophetic teachings of Apostle Leroy Thompson. God is preparing a new generation of believers who are able to FLOW as lead by the Holy Spirit at a moment's notice.

Transformation Institute Online Course Offerings

Transformation Institute online Instruction will take place on the LearnDash platform that can be accessed through the TI webpage. Students will be required to review the LearnDash Orientation video before the start of classes. Students are required to have all reading materials needed for each course. Classes will be 4-5 weeks of prerecorded or Live Zoom sessions 60-90 minutes of instruction once a week. When Live Zoom or Prerecorded sessions are conduction students will have 5 days from the posted date to review the session and complete assignments/quizzes.

Completion of all quizzes and assignment are required for the completion of the course. The completion of quizzes and assignments will serve as weekly attendance. Due to the flexibility of online instruction no quizzes will be reopened after the close date. Students will have access to their instructor through email on the Learn Dash platform for course related question only. Students will receive a successful completion of the course with weekly attendance, watching/attending all classes, and completion of all quizzes/assignments.

Course Overview

The instructor will start the Live Zoom session promptly with a welcome and a review of the syllabus. Each student should have read the course syllabus and familiarize themselves with the online platform (LearnDash). LearnDash is the online platform used for managing all course content and materials. Students are expected to have basic technology skills to participate in Live Zoom sessions and access the Learn Dash platform.

Students are expected to have basic technology skills to participate in Live Zoom sessions and access the LearnDash platform. Each Course is divided into 4-5 Live Zoom sessions, lessons, quizzes, and class participation challenges. For most courses, assigned readings will come from one or more books. Each course contains graded assignments, quizzes which are uploaded to the LearnDash platform. Many course quizzes are typically comprised of multiple choice, matching, and or true false questions. Students will be expected to complete all assignment and quizzes in LearnDash. These assignments are graded instantly in LearnDash. While the course is self-pace, you should attend all classes, read, work through lessons, submit your work on the LearnDash platform, and contact your instructor as you have questions.

Transformation Institute On Site Course Offerings

Onsite instruction will take place at MT. Gilead in a designated classroom in the building. Students are required to attend all onsite classes that he or she registered for. Students are required to purchase all books and material needs for the course. Students are expected to arrive on time or before the 10-minute grace period to get credit for the class. Student must sign in before each class.

Students are expected to compete all quizzes and assignment provided by the instructor. Students are responsible for returning all written assignments / worksheet given by the instructor. All electronic assignments/quizzes will be upload on the LearnDash platform. Students will have 5 days to complete all assignment/quizzes. No quizzes will be reopened after the close date.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

COURSE REGISTRATIONS

CLASS ATTENDANCE POLICY

ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED IN <u>ALL</u> CLASSES! <u>ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND ALL</u> <u>THE CLASSES FOR THE COURSE(S) THEY HAVE REGISTERED FOR.</u>

Exceptions to this policy will be taken into consideration when a student is Providentially Hindered from attending a session.

Providentially Hindered: To be prevented from attendance due to circumstances beyond human control which make it impossible for the student to comply.

CLASS PUNCTUALITY POLICY

ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ARRIVE AT THEIR RESPECTIVE CLASSES ON TIME! There will be a grace period of 10 minutes given for participants who arrive late for class. Participants will be marked as "**INCOMPLETE**" if they arrive late for **2 or more classes**. We encourage you to get to your classes on time!!!

ACADEMIC STANDARDS

Class Assignments, Homework, Quizzes & Tests

ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO COMPLETE ALL CLASS ASSIGNMENTS, HOMEWORK, QUIZZES & TESTS NO LATER THAN THE INSTRUCTOR'S DEADLINE.

Failure to meet these academic standards <u>will result in the student not being eligible to</u> <u>continue with the course and not being eligible to receive a certificate of completion.</u>

Students will be responsible for watching all assigned videos as well as completing and submitting homework assignments, quizzes, and tests through the online classroom.

All TI students will be required to learn and be

be familiar with the online classroom system and you will be responsible for making sure that your computer software is up to date to access all archived classes, exams, and quizzes.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT: Upon registration, all TI students will be provided with a User ID and a Temporary Password (password will need to be reset once on the site) and the link to access TI courses and classrooms.

All aspects of how to navigate within the TI LearnDash Portal are available once a student has logged in and those students needing more technical support are required to watch the "Student How To" tutorial videos and read the "Student How To" resource document located on the LearnDash portal. Should a student require additional assistance accessing the classroom portal, technical support will be provided on site following the first session of all courses.

CERTIFICATES OF COMPLETION

Successful Completion: At the conclusion of the training course, all assigned class work, homework, quizzes, and tests will be assessed and graded to evaluate successful completion of the course.

Only those students who have successfully completed course assignments as deemed by the Primary Instructor for each course will receive a Certificate of Completion.
